Privacy

The use of our website is generally possible without the statement of personal data. Should personal data be demanded on our websites (such as name, post address oder email) the statement of such always happens on a voluntary basis. This data will not be forwarded to third parties without your explicit approval.

We have to point out however, that the communication of data through the internet (like the communication via email) may show security leaks. A complete protection of data against the access by third parties is not possible.

Data Communication
